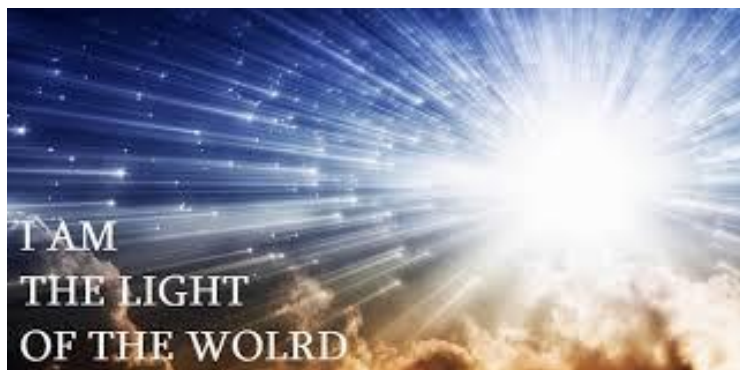


Praying through this week 16th November 2020
