## Sundays

**Prayer** The prayer life of St. Paul's is vibrant and ever growing. There are many different ways in which we can offer our gifts of prayer. If you sense God calling you to know more about our prayer life, please have a chat with Carole Rose.

**Welcome Team** On a rota approx. every 6 weeks, needed at either 8.30am, 10.00am, or SIX:30 and special services. Working in pairs, you are the first point of contact to welcome everyone at services. Also supporting the wardens and worship leaders to ensure the service runs smoothly. **Music** We are looking for guitar, bass and keyboard players as well as vocalists to be part of the Worship Team at the 10.00am and SIX:30 services. Flexible rota commitment. Speak to Ali Ribchester for more information.

**Audio** Operating sound system in church and output for the live stream at 10.00am, SIX:30 and seasonal services. This role is key to enabling the congregation to hear and receive the sermon and also to participate in worship. Approximate rota once every 4-6 weeks. Speak to Jonathan Hughes for more information.

**Camera** Operating the cameras from the church office that are displayed in church and for the live stream. This role also includes working with the in church audio team to provide audio for the live stream. 10.00am and SIX:30 services, approximate rota once per month. **Visuals** Compiling the slides for the service and operating the visual overlays for projecting in church and the live stream for the 10.00am and SIX:30 services. This role is operated from the church office and is key to allowing the congregation and those at home to respond in word and worship. Approximate rota once per month. **Refreshments** Served after the 10.00am service in the hall and before the SIX:30 service.

10.00am - Teams of 2 arrive by 9.30am to set up in the kitchen and then serve refreshments and clear up after the service. Speak to Hazel Barratt for more information.

SIX:30 - Served in the church before the service, arrive by 5.45pm to set up. On a rota approximately once a month. Speak to Derek Snow for more information.

**Readings** You will be asked to read 2 or 3 times a year at the 10.00am service and occasional special services. All new readers have a brief training session in Church.

**Lifts to church** Giving a lift to the 8.30am and 10.00am service to people who otherwise are unable to come. Generally 4 lifts in 3 months. Speak to Nigel Carrick for more information.
