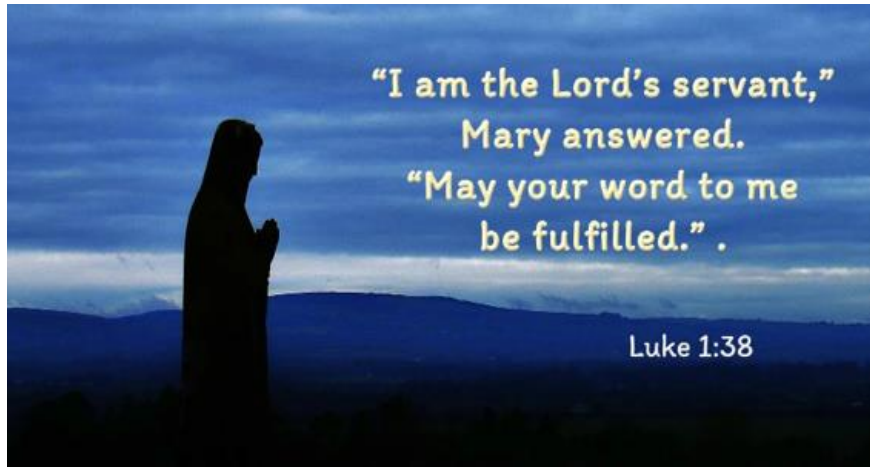


Praying Through This Week 18th July 2022

Reflective, searching, ...?

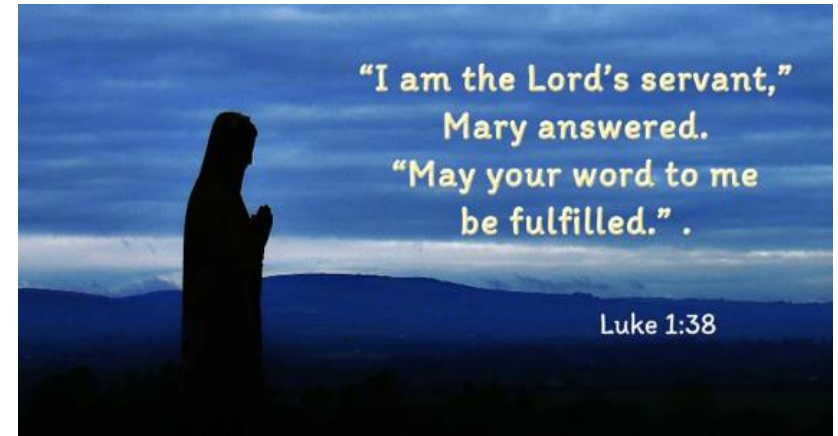
“They all joined together constantly in prayer, along with the women and Mary the mother of Jesus, ...” Acts 1:14
