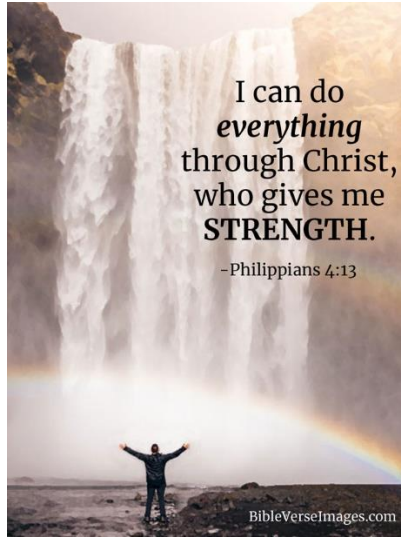


Praying Through This Week 20th November 2022 – Duty
