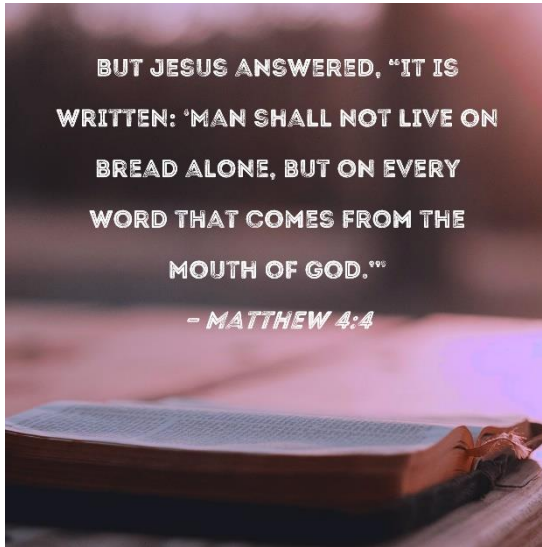


Praying through the week 24th April 2023

“The word of God is living and active ...” (Hebrews 4:12)

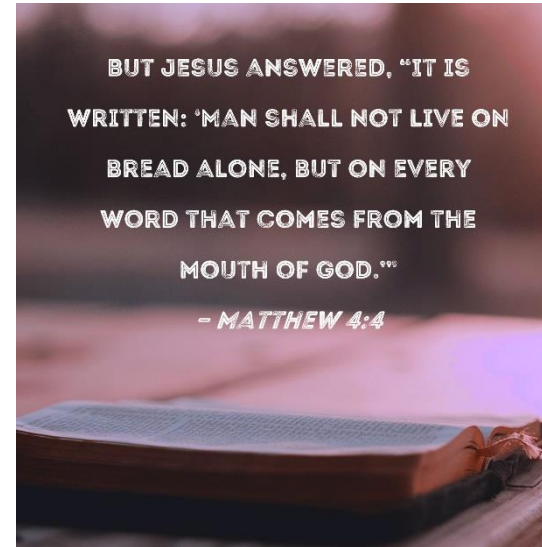
Can you recall times when God has spoken to you through a Bible verse that seemed so relevant to your situation?
