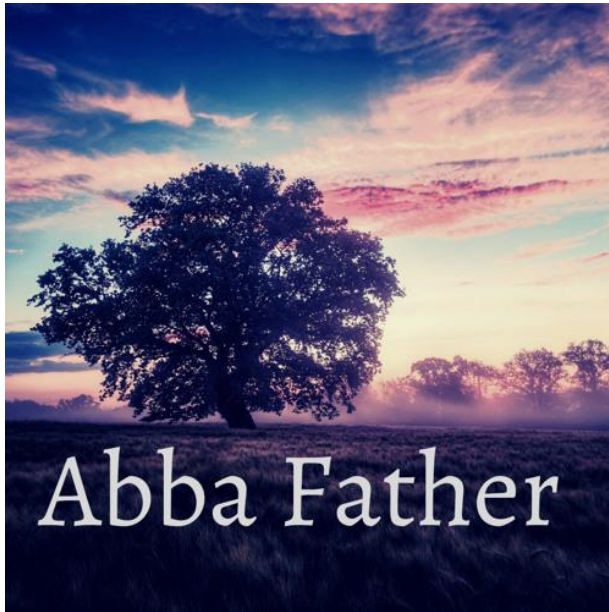


Praying through the week 26th June 2023

(New Living Translation - Galatians 4:6)

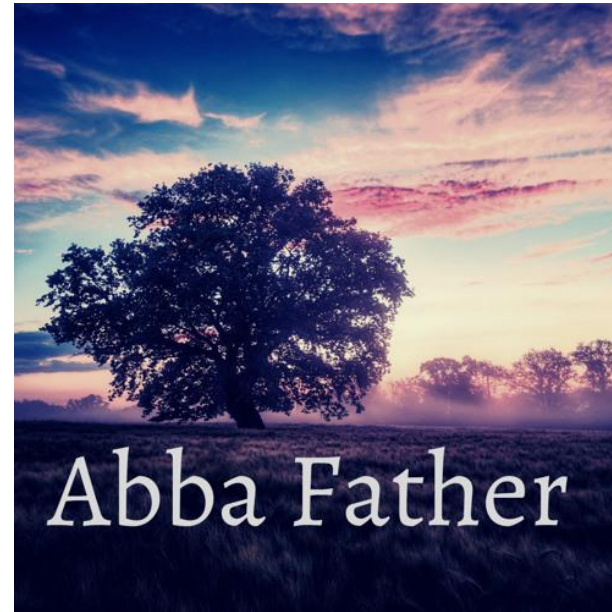
