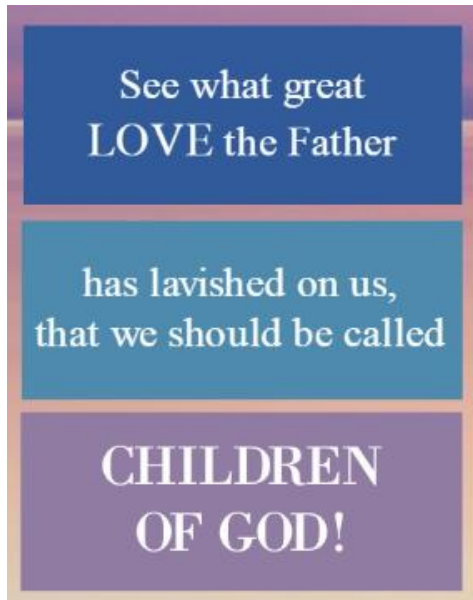


Praying through the week 5th June 2023
