Praying through the week 26th May 2025 ""Jesus said to her, 'Mary'. She turned towards him and cried out in Aramaic, 'Rabboni!'" (John 20:16)



Mary Magdalene expressed her deep love for Jesus in various ways: She, along with some other women, followed Jesus from Galilee to Jerusalem to care for Him and she kept watch at the cross as Jesus suffered and died (Matthew 27:55). She went very early on 'the first day of the week' to anoint Jesus' body with spices in an act of reverence and love.


How do we like to express our love for Jesus? In what ways have we done so this week?

John, in his gospel account, tells us that Mary was the first person to discover that the tomb was empty. Can we picture her as she stands outside the tomb, weeping, distraught because she thinks His body has been taken away and she doesn't know where He is? She turns her head ... and sees someone standing there She doesn't recognise that it's Jesus ... until He says her name, 'Mary'. What a tender, intimate moment between Mary and her Lord as she simply replies, 'Rabboni!'

Do we sometimes fail to recognise Jesus' presence ... in our own lives ... in our community ... in the world around us? Can you remember a time when you heard Jesus call you by your name? Perhaps you would like to spend a moment with Jesus cherishing that memory? Maureen

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
