


Praying through the week 8th September 2025

“At Gibeon, the Lord appeared to Solomon during the night in a dream, and God said, ‘Ask for whatever you want me to give you.’”


“So give your servant a discerning heart to govern your people and to distinguish between right and wrong. For who is able to govern this great people of yours?” – 1 Kings 3: 5&9
