Some discussion questions for Home Groups below on the basis of Sunday's sermon;

- The Old Testament is not often associated with freedom, where else in the OT do we see God at work to set his people free?
- What do the Kings we heard about on Sunday tell us about leadership?
- How does freedom in Christ differ to the perception of worldly freedom?
- If God was always going to set his people free why didn't he do it earlier?
- What do we think about "prospective" and "retrospective" grace? (In other words is it possible to be free in Christ if you lied before Christ?)
- We heard that 1 and 2 Kings is considered one of the "History" texts, how do we interpret the non-historical texts such as the poetry of Song of Songs? Where can we find freedom in those non-historical parts of the Bible?
- Jesus sets us free, lets share examples of where that setting free has been experienced in our own lives
